## Subject: Semester VI U.G. End Semester ExamApril 2021 guidelines (SXCA)

#### Introduction:

Taking into account the current situation of the pandemic, and the concerns expressed by all stakeholders as well as the UGC guidelines which emphasize the Issues of Safety, Honesty, Connectivity, Professionalism and Fairness, St Xavier's College (Autonomous), Ahmedabad, proposes the following End Semester April 2021 Examination system guidelines for UG Semester VIstudents of the College. It is to be noted that this alternative mode of examination is offered specifically on account of the current pandemic.

#### **Guidelines/ Instructions:**

<u>UG students of SemesterVI</u>will have an Assignment plus Viva-voce pattern of examination, as per the decision taken by the Exam committee.

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## Departments offering the Written Assignment plus viva-voce:

- <u>Written assignment plus Viva-voce</u>: The written assignment followed by viva-voce examination method will be used for each of the papers (Internal as well as External) including the practical paper. The subject faculty will give ONE assignment for the 70 marks to be answered by the student. Multiple assignments sets may be prepared for each paper by the Department depending on the number of students.
- The assignment will comprise of 4 questions, corresponding to the 4 units in the paper. The student is expected to answer all 4 questions in his/her own handwriting. The electronic copy must be handwritten, scanned and converted to pdf. It is to be noted that marks will be given for originality, content, subject depth, relevance. The content must be free from plagiarism. Written assignment must be submitted in the students own handwriting failure to do so may be considered as unfair means and could attract disciplinary action.
- The student shall submit the assignments / reports within the period stipulated by the particular department. Extension of time may be permitted on special request.
- It is the duty of the student to ensure that the electronic copy of the written assignment (in pdf format) is reached to the Department Head/ faculty by way of requesting acknowledgement confirmation from the Head/ faculty.
- Upon receipt of the written assignment of that particular paper, the subject faculty shall conduct viva-voce. The viva-voce schedule can be arranged depending upon the convenience of the student and the subject faculty.
- The purpose of the viva-voce examination is to (a) demonstrate that the assignment is the work of the student concerned; (b) confirm that the student understands what has been written and can defend it verbally. Marks will be given for the Assignment and viva taken together for a given question.
- The viva-voce will be of 20-25 minutes' duration which is to be recorded by the Professor/s concerned.
